

PhD AWARD

This award prize is provided by Professor **Tomas Kron** to the BHT Foundation and recognises the best PhD thesis in Physical and Engineering Sciences with relevance for medicine.

Award: \$500 plus a certificate

Minimum Criteria:

Postgraduate students will have been awarded their PhD at an Australian or New Zealand university from 1st January previous year to 30 June, the current year)

Judging Criteria:

The thesis should possess:

- Clinical relevance
- Scientific merit and novelty
- Publication capacity arising from the work
- Content that aligns with objectives of ACPSEM and the professional roles of ACPSEM members

You will need someone (supervisor or colleague) to nominate you for this award.

Recent prior winners and their PhD research topics are listed on the BHT Foundation website.

How to Apply

Applicants to submit:

- A brief letter of justification (no more than 1 page) typically by the nominator
- An abstract of the thesis
- A brief CV of the nominee including a list of current publications
- A copy of the PhD certificate of the nominee including a mark where applicable
- Contact details (email(s) and mobile no.)

- Thumbnail photograph

Successful award winner(s) of the PhD Award will be contacted by the BHT Foundation. There is an expectation that upon acceptance of the winning prize, the award winner will commit to writing an article describing their PhD research for publication on the betterhealthcaretechnology.org website within 3 months of receiving their award.

The article should be aimed at a general non-academic audience and can be drawn from the executive summary of the thesis work, with research summary tables and/or any accompanying images. Winning parties can liaise with the BHT Foundation webmaster (or their agent) regarding final length and style of this article. All required accreditations and content / image copyright acknowledgement will be provided to the prize winners as the exclusive article authors for any such content.
