



RICHARD BATES TRAVEL AWARD

This scholarship honours the ACPSEM's third President, Richard Bates, Professor of Electrical Engineering at the University of Canterbury, Christchurch. His particular expertise was in the field of signal and image processing, and he supervised more than 50 masters and doctoral students, many of whom are current College members.

The scholarship is awarded to assist a physical scientist or engineer to undertake a period of study or research project overseas. The scholarship is awarded to members whose projects are perceived to be of broad benefit to the profession of physical and engineering sciences in medicine. The intent of this award is to advance research in medical physics or biomedical engineering.

Recent prior winners and their research topics are listed on the BHT Foundation website.

Prize: Maximum value of scholarship is \$5000AUD

Minimum Criteria:

- A financial Associate Member of ACPSEM of 12 months standing
- Engaged in project work perceived to be of broad benefit to the College and/or the profession

Judging Criteria:

Criteria used for judging this Award include, but are not limited to:

- The application is to undertake a period of study or research overseas beyond simply attending a conference or brief site visit
- The project advances research in medical physics, radiopharmaceutical sciences or biomedical engineering
- The project is of broad benefit to the ACPSEM or profession
- A detailed and realistic plan has been submitted
- Capability of the applicant to deliver the proposed project





How to Apply

Applicants to provide:

- Details of Study or Research Proposal, together with
- Evidence such as publications record to demonstrate the benefit criteria requirement to ACPSEM and/ or the medical sciences profession can be met.
- Thumbnail photograph
